About this roadmap

This document outlines the public mission, positioning, and strategic orientation of **LIGNES DE FUITE (LDF)** for the period **2025–2030**.

It is intended to serve as a reference for partners, institutions, collaborators, and the public. It defines **what LDF is, why it exists, and how it operates within the Québec fashion ecosystem**.

Operational details may evolve over time. The structural mission remains constant.

1. What is LIGNES DE FUITE

LIGNES DE FUITE operates as **post-educational transition infrastructure** for independent fashion designers.

It intervenes **after formal education and before economic stabilization**, at a critical moment when many trained designers leave the field due to lack of continuity, access, and professional conditions.

LDF is not a school. It is not a traditional incubator. It is not solely an event platform.

It is a **working structure** that connects: - Design - Production - Image - Market - Transmission

2. Mission

LIGNES DE FUITE exists to **support the long-term viability of independent fashion practice**.

Its mission is to: - Retain trained talent within the ecosystem - Provide continuity after graduation - Offer access to professional tools, resources, and networks - Reconnect creative practice with real economic conditions

3. Vision 2030

By 2030, LIGNES DE FUITE is: - A recognized cultural and economic institution in Québec - A permanent physical infrastructure dedicated to independent fashion - A reference model for post-educational continuity in fashion - A place where creation, production, visibility, and sales coexist

LDF contributes to talent retention, job creation, and the strengthening of the local fashion ecosystem.

4. Strategic Axes (2025–2030)

Post-Graduation Continuity & Talent Retention

Structured mentoring, designer residencies, and long-term follow-up to stabilize careers.

Advanced Training & Learning Through Practice

Post-school, applied units focused on real production, image-making, and professional skills.

Shared Resources & Mutualization

Access to equipment, workspaces, and specialized human resources through flexible shared models.

Production, Visibility & Market Access

Fashion events, exhibitions, retail platforms, and professional documentation connecting creation to market.

Ecosystem Integration & Partnerships

Collaboration with educational institutions, industry bodies, cultural partners, and public stakeholders.

5. Role in the Ecosystem

LIGNES DE FUITE functions as: - A bridge between education and industry - A stabilization mechanism for emerging careers - A delivery structure for public-interest objectives - A durable cultural and economic infrastructure
